



Summer Camp General Information

Days: Monday - Friday

2024 Dates: June 17 - 21 (no June 19)* // June 24 - 28 // July 1- 3 (no July 4 or 5)* // July 8 - 12 // July 15 - 19 // July 22 - 26 // July 29 - August 2 // August 5 - 9

Time: 9:00AM - 12:00PM

Fee: \$400 per week (*shorter holiday weeks are \$320 for 4 days and \$240 for 3 days).

Please note: Campers should bring a healthy, nut-free, mid-morning snack each day to camp.

To Register:

- There is a 3 week maximum registration per child (in an effort to make our camp weeks available to more families, we have instituted a 3 week maximum participation for each child).
- Children must be the appropriate age for each camp (and potty trained) by June 1, 2024.
- Please be sure to fill in all information requested online. We will be following up with every registrant for full contact and camper information.

Cancellation Policy/Refunds:

- A refund, less a \$75 processing fee, will be granted if you wish to withdraw your child from camp prior to June 1, 2024.
- A 50% refund will be issued if you cancel after June 1st but in advance of 2 weeks prior to your child's scheduled camp start date.
- Refunds will not be granted if you cancel within 2 weeks of your child's scheduled camp start date.
- Each weekly program requires a minimum number of campers. Full refunds are given only if Featherstone cancels the camp.

Pick-up and Drop-off:

Each camp will run from 9:00AM to 12:00PM Monday through Friday (except for two short holiday weeks). At drop-off, please walk your camper to the appropriate studio classroom and sign them in with the camp teacher(s). Featherstone staff will be on the road to direct families day one of each week. Campers will not be permitted to leave until their Parent/Guardian has arrived at the studio classroom for pick-up at noon.

* Children should bring a healthy, nut-free, mid-morning snack.
